3. How We Collect Information

We collect personal data when you:

- Register for events
- Subscribe to newsletters
- Contact us via email or website
- Participate in our webinars or activities
- Use our digital services or website

4. Purpose of Processing

We process personal data to:

- Manage events and memberships
- Send newsletters and relevant updates
- Communicate with participants and partners
- Promote Women in Tech Norway activities
- Document and share photos/videos from events
- Improve our services and website experience

5. Legal Basis for Processing

We process personal data based on:

- Consent
- Contractual necessity
- Legitimate interests
- Legal obligations

You may withdraw your consent at any time.

6. Sharing of Information

We never sell personal data.

We may share information with:

- Technology service providers
- Event partners
- Newsletter platforms
- Public authorities if legally required

All third parties are required to process data securely and in compliance with GDPR.

7. Data Retention

We only retain personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose for which it was collected, or as required by law.

8. Your Rights

Under GDPR, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Request the deletion of your data
- Restrict processing
- Object to processing
- Request data portability
- Withdraw consent at any time
